- ANZREG Seminar was held in Melbourne, Australia in January 2010 at the State Library of Victoria. It was a very successful seminar with good representation from across the region (103 attendees, including 14 Ex Libris staff)
- Next year we are holding a one day Technical Seminar for the first time. We are planning this with Ex Libris to coincide with some Voyager Certification Training the week before (in January 2011).

- Some discussion had with Ex Libris and ANZREG about the regional Australia/New Zealand URM partnership based on the strong representation from the region on the URM Focus Groups
- New web site to be launched soon, including social networking site "Ning" as part of the launch.
- Strategic directions paper written, with issues around membership, seminar costs, technical seminars, other activities and a focus on involving more members from the wider Asia/Pacific region
