

Brigham Young University in Utah, USA designed a custom, standalone Primo user interface that integrates to Primo completely via API's.

• Why?

 They wanted more control of the user interface design than they could achieve through the standard mechanisms (Back Office Views Wizard, CSS, and HTML) and to manage their own release schedule
