





#### GOBI Real Time Acquisitions Workflow




GOBI Real Time Acquisitions replaced GOBI orders/EOCRS or GobiExport/EDI ordering.

Real Time Acquisitions is a process that occurs almost simultaneously.

At UniSA this changed the process for point of order but not point of shipment/invoicing





#### GOBI PO Line Summary Screen in Alma





Real-time acquisitions is an integration between ExLibris Alma and Academic Library Service Providers, to streamline acquisitions workflows. It incorporates standard ordering and loading technologies with APIs to speed the availability of resources, increase the efficiency of integrating records, and enhance data enrichment.


#### Workflow

Related blogs

- The user searches for items in the vendor's system, and places them in the shopping cart (or equivalent).
- The user verifies owning library, fund codes and other relevant information.
- At checkout, the vendor sends the shopping cart data to Alma using the Create PO line API.
- · Alma validates the received PO line information (see PO line object)
- Alma attempts to match the bibliographic data using standard identifiers. If no match is found, Alma creates a brief bibliographic record for the order.
- Alma responds with the newly created PO line number to the vendor.
- The PO line is processed in Alma as other PO lines are processed. If an order requires manual review, Alma sends it to the *In Review* task list.

The **vendor reference number** is kept as part of the Alma PO line. **Alma PO line number** is kept as part of the vendor order details.

Brief bib data only



#### **Future Enhancements**



Distinguish P and E for matching purposes

Handling/Matching on other control numbers

Allow for manual selection by library where there are multiple matches

Real-time duplication check against Alma when ordering in GOBI


#### ■ EDI integration in Alma

Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) is a method of communication between an institution and its vendors. Alma supports the EDIFACT standard, which is managed by EDIFEUR.

The following workflows are supported:

- From Alma to vendor: Purchase orders, Claims, Cancellations
- From vendor to Alma: Invoices, Order Responses

The EDI based communication between Alma and the vendor is done using a FTP location in which EDI files are placed and fetched for processing. This is illustrated in the following diagram:


