- La Trobe University: Deputy Director, Research & Collections (2015-)
 2 Divisions: Research Team; Collections & Access Team
 (53 staff). Went live with Alma and Primo on 29 January 2015
- La Trobe University: Digital infrastructure manager (2012-2014)

Library discovery/systems team; audio-visual & copyright team; repository team (12 staff). Initiated project to move from Millennium & Summon to Alma & Primo in 2014.


- State Library of Victoria: Business Applications Development manager (2009-2012)
 Web development; Voyager, DigiTool, Primo, SFX, MetaLib; database management; applications development (10 staff)
- Monash University: Library Systems Manager (2000-2009)
 Library system; Web development; Lectures Online; IT Support (16 staff)


Primo at State Library of Victoria (Primo local)

- Primo version 2 implemented in 2009 with OPAC via Primo connecting to Voyager
 OPAC
- Highly customised web presence
- Ambitious SLV21 Program (2007-2011) to implement new systems: DigiTool, Primo,
 MetaLib and SFX.
- On-site requesting/callslip retrieval of local physical (closed) collections with complex/different instructions for some
- A number of specific physical collections/formats (eg. Manuscrips, pictures, maps, books, serials, AV material, realia, etc)
- Large/ambitious digitisation program

Primo at State Library of Victoria


- Customisations
 - Thumbnail images
 - Icons
 - Very specific fonts/styling/style guide
 - Request forms
 - Holdings (users can't browse shelves of closed access items)
 - DigiTool integration
 - Direct Delivery integration


Primo at La Trobe University (Multi-tenanted Saas)

- Organisational restructure in 2014
 - knowledge had to be transparent and transferrable
- Less staff
- No dedicated Systems Librarian (or unit) any more
- Systems work is part of Discovery and Systems Services team (including e-resources and troubleshooting)
- Do minimal styling (once)
- Needed a fully integrated system (Alma & Primo) for managing everything on once place
- ICT/University strategy to move systems to the Cloud

Primo at La Trobe University (Multi-tenanted Saas)

- Basic styling
- Initial search box located on our home page (search scopes, etc)
- My Account link on home page
- Working through gradual changes Alma; activating e-resources; reading lists, ILL have been the focus
- 2 views only (OPAC and LATROBE/MAIN)
- Our focus for searching is e-resources and PCI; with some customisation of search parameters and collections
- No on-site v off-site views (authentication through ezproxy link)



Local v Saas Comparison

Primo local	Primo SaaS (Cloud)
Patches / upgrades to be applied by local IT staff (with knowledge of the system)	Automatic updates (3 per year)
Downtime required for scheduled upgrades; Notices required; other systems (Voyager) affected	Minimal downtime
Backups, etc set by IT department (may involve downtime)	Server continuity and backups managed by Ex Libris
Access to server back-end (depending on IT environment)	No access. Some changes require Support Incident.
Primo Back Office	Primo Back Office
Usage log files can be kept and analysed; Primo Analytics	Primo Analytics
Can schedule any jobs	Can schedule some jobs via Back Office
Local / fast response	Server located in Singapore

Downtime issues



Scheduled downtime:

3 maintenance incidents.

Unscheduled downtime:

2 incidents.

Scheduled downtime:

2 maintenance incidents.

Unscheduled downtime:

6 incidents.

Conclusion

- Productivity is up
- Some issues have taken months to resolve (but related to initial setup)
- We can't make changes other sites have made
- Don't have staff time for complex styling; javascript; programming on the server anyway
- Digital experience (web) team are busy with Digital Learning and Digital Literacies agenda
- Focus is on fast/better responses to users, rather than detailed customised interfaces
- Focus on bigger picture integration (eg. Alma with Finance/SIS, Reading Lists within LMS/Moodle, etc)
- Use of APIs instead of customised interfaces
