Ustat Configuration & Usage

Limitations of working with vendor data in USTAT

- some sectors of the publishing industry had not adopted either COUNTER-compliant usage reporting standards or SUSHI automated data upload
- there is more than one COUNTER standard,
- when loading large files there are problems with data integrity &
- title matching is sometimes problematic.

Ustat Configuration & Usage

Ustat has the potential to demonstrate:

- Usage statistics by journal
- Usage statistics by database
- Usage statistics by publisher
- Usage statistics by platform
- Usage statistics by subscriber
- Cost usage statistics by title
- Cost usage statistics by platform

Ustat Configuration & Usage


Integrating USTAT & Alma Analytics reporting

- Cost information is extracted from Alma via PO line information
- Usage data is extracted from Ustat tables (not UResolver data)
- Ustat data is refreshed in Alma analytics weekly.


