Rosetta Systems Operations

Format Library Working Group

This group will focus on operating procedures and workflows for the Rosetta Format Library, providing a forum for co-ordinating Format Library updates, and identification of enhancements that will extend the functionality of the Format Library

Delivery and Integrations

Focuses on issues related to traditional DAMS such as delivery, publishing and access rights

API monitoring

Integrations to external systems and standards such as IIF, library catalogues, archival management systems, and other DAM systems

Digital Preservation Group

Focuses on practices of long-term digital preservation and data archiving.

Consider the implementation and integration of, as well as conformance, to standards and schemas, including PREMIS, METS and DNX.

Rosetta Systems Operations

Focuses on issues relating to the way Rosetta operates and how data moves through the system, such as deposit workflows, SIP processing, TA/3A workbenches, UI, search, and reporting

Focuses on issues of system security, performance, scalability and extensibility, including technical aspects of integration such as the plugin framework/APIs etc
