# Feedback on the PWG licensing report

- The PWG on licensing has been working with Ex Libris to add more functionality to the licensing area.
- In 2015 they will introduce the ability to link to closed and cancelled orders, link to multi POs, add locally defined terms and create local controlled vocabulary.
- In 2016 interoperable with group settings for electronic inventory, read only roles, and the functionality to export from the license tab using tools will be included.
- Areas that require further discussion with Ex Libris are around adding local fields, incorporating licensing into the physical workflow, distinguishing between different types of licenses, flexibility in how license terms are discoverable, adding terms and reordering in the terms tab.
