- The NERS enhancement process remains a core activity and a focus for collaboration between the IGeLU and ELUNA Working Groups
- Preparing the ballot, deduping and clarifying the enhancement suggestions is a valuable but time-consuming process and requires the work of a dedicated and knowledgeable team



NERS - Primo / Alma

 The enhancement process was tweaked this year to align with the Alma enhancement process and allow easy transfer of enhancement requests between the two where required – each year's process is reviewed once complete to improve efficiency and transparency wherever possible

 The top voting results are currently with Ex Libris for pointing, but there may be the need for a second round of voting
