- Pilot began Semester 1 2017
- 2018 almost 100 operational reading lists
- In 2019 plan a full rollout - 650 Semester 1 courses
- Library systems staff currently working with IT to build an integration between Peoplesoft Enrolments (course data) and Alma to automate loading of course information.
- Still in planning stage to determine exactly how this will look

On rollover **Keep course instructors**

On rollover visibility of old reading list **Course Students**

Schedule **Not scheduled**

- File must be TXT (tab delimited) - CSV did not read – this may work now
- Cannot rollover a reading list if course already exists – refer to published SF case 00610450
- Many row values must be in capitals e.g. (Operation) ROLLOVER
- Currently issues with Campus data – refer to published SF case 00592189
- If considering multiple course association to one reading list, course rollover is not yet supported. (October release notes)
