Business rules around how a title can match

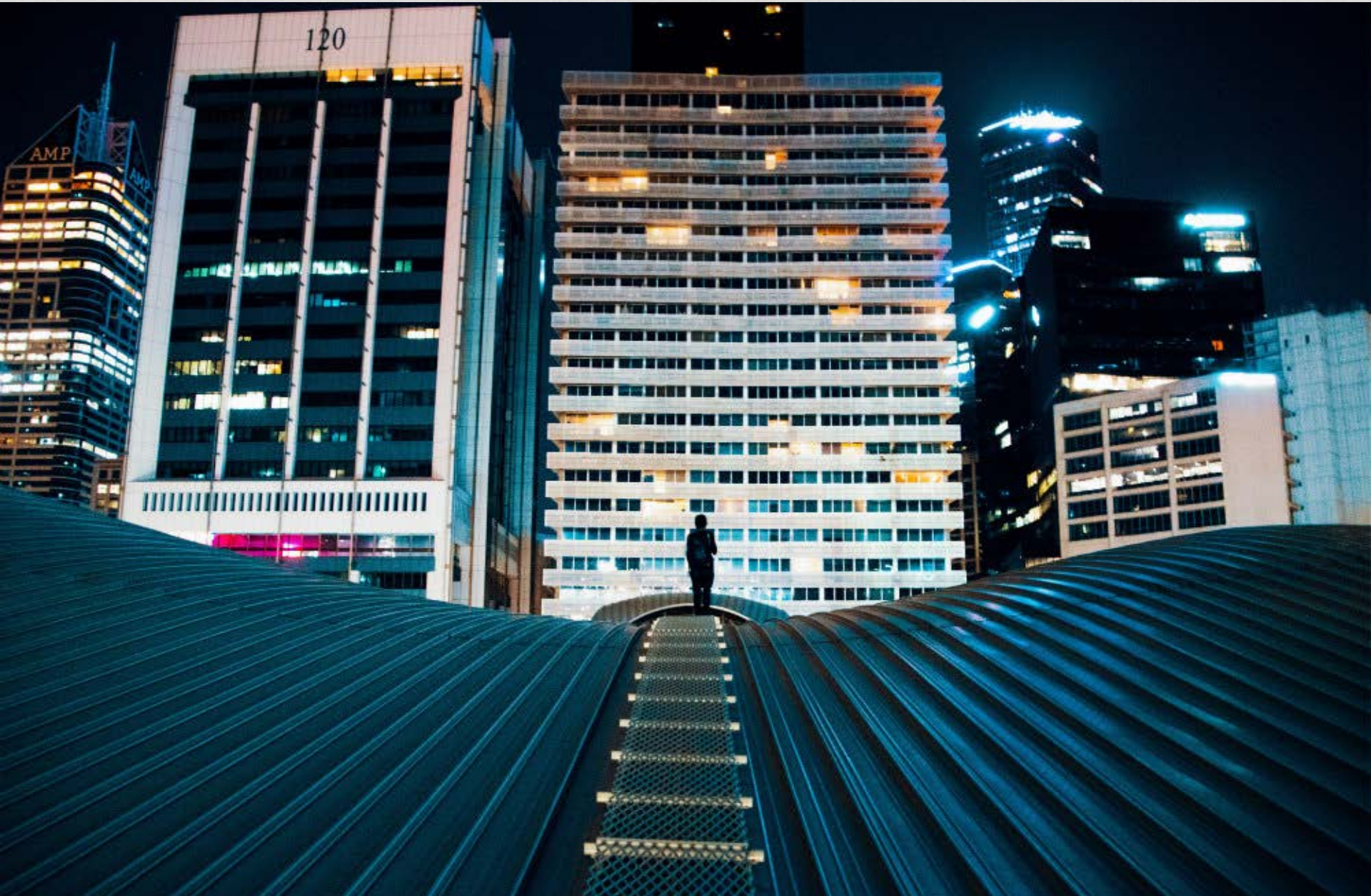


Results

- 20,000 books (~ 15% of the physical book collection) matched via ISBN to an ebook
- Another 5,000 matched via title but not ISBN
- Quality of the title matched was not deemed good enough
- CARM and Primo suppression
- Of the latest batch of 15,000. 278 have been brought back from CARM (2 month period)
