Time lines

- Preview server released July 2008
- Customisation of preview db with new skins setup 15 Sept 2008
- Ongoing customisation work
- Upgrade performed by ExL 19-21 Nov 2008
- One week of instability (due to new architecture – more on this later)
- Ongoing customisation



OPAC

- **New interface is a modern, flexible new architecture which gives us many options to do this type of work properly.**
- **Many issues that were identified in our own usability testing in 2003/4 are now finally able to be resolved.**
- **Accessibility is very good.**
- **User acceptance generally good (providing not using IE 6)**



Monash Customisation

- Customise webvoyage.properties (from opac/search/limits.ini etc)
- Translate cfg files to XML format
- Apply Monash branding requirements
- Select 'recipes' and apply
- Hide limits on the advanced search page
- Display persistent link
- Display cover images

Internet Explorer 6 problems

Some users of the catalogue may be experiencing problems since the system was upgraded in November. Many of these problems have to do with using Internet Explorer 6.

The catalogue does not work in IE6. Pages are very slow to load and although all the content is there, it is poorly laid out.

The Library is working with the vendor to correct these issues, but in the meantime users are advised to try an alternate browser. The site works best in Firefox 2+, but results are acceptable in recent versions of most browsers, including IE7.

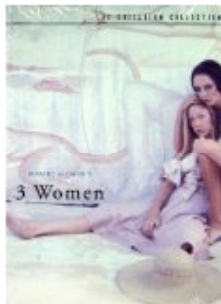

Monash Customisation

- Enabled external authentication
- Enable Monash specific enhancements – tabs for
 - Electronic resources search
 - Reading list search
 - New title (not implemented yet)
- Set up simultaneous searching (not implemented yet)



Technical Issues

- Apache and Tomcat – can be confusing
- There are 38 predefined tomcat mount URL's which determines when apache hands over to tomcat.
- If you are writing enhancements or serving additional pages via apache you must be careful not to name the file or URL to one the tomcat mount URL's, ie /vwebv/log*.
- Solaris 10 and SMF



Problems

- We did have a list of 70 or so items which were causing us problems relating to:
 - - Whole MARC fields or subfields missing or cut-off in record display
 - - Requests pending display not working properly (in my loans - pickup item available)
 - - URL links have all changed
 - - Export/print/save of records not working properly (this is a known bug)
 - - Error pages not meaningful in Tomcat (need customising)
 - - Item statuses not displaying properly (titles view shows Available when something is not)
 - - Column widths, white space and funny displays (in IE 7)
 - - Limit type and drop down box aren't functioning as expected
 - - General slowness in displaying record page - due to long display and browser issues



Tips

- CSS - use Firebug (a Firefox plugin)
- XML/XSL - enable 'Show XML'
- Javascript – keep accessibility in mind
- Check bugs/issues/fixes (Pivotal & voyager-I)
- Install Classic



IGeLU issues

- From a user group perspective, the IGeLU and ELUNA groups have recommended improvements to collaborative testing to help with some of these issues.
- We did do collaborative testing of Voyager 7 in January 2008 (Betsy Earl was our local rep) which successfully identified a number of issues which were fixed before Voyager 8 was released.

- Preview server - This was invaluable
- New version v good job - esp Google Books & Google Analytics
- Configuration Webinars session - very worthwhile
- Experience in configuration of previous versions - helps
- Experience in XML helps. Firebug is very useful
- Changed file structure - very frustrating
- Different XML coding for some characters
- Bugs or other problems - I have found some 'funnies'.
- Look and feel - difficult to apply the University template
- CSS experience needed
- Time to configure - took a lot longer than I expected.
- Manuals - The manuals are not that detailed.
